

**Winnisquam Chamber Singers
Contract**

The following policies will be strictly enforced to ensure a “top-notch” group and help us to continue the tradition of excellence that we now enjoy.

1. All singers must be enrolled at Winnisquam Regional High School
2. All singers must be members of the Concert Choir
3. All singers must maintain satisfactory academic progress
Students who fail a course will be placed on academic probation until the grade is brought to passing. Students on academic probation are not able to participate in any Chamber Singer events. Once on academic probation, there is no guarantee a student will be reinstated to the group. A student may be reinstated to the group only once per academic year. Any student who remains on academic probation for 2 consecutive quarters will be dismissed from the group for the remainder of the year.
Students are expected to work to their full potential at all times.
4. Any infractions of Winnisquam Regional High School’s academic integrity policy will result in dismissal.
5. Students are expected to exhibit extraordinary citizenship in the school and community. All students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will not bring harm, danger, embarrassment, disgrace or discomfort to themselves or any member of the Winnisquam Chamber Singers.
6. Students are expected to attend classes. Any student who receives two (2) unexcused absences in a course will be dismissed from the choir.
7. Suspensions (in or out of school) will result in dismissal.
8. Use of drugs or alcohol will result in immediate dismissal.
9. Attendance at all concerts is mandatory. An unexcused absence from a performance will result in automatic dismissal.
10. Students are responsible for knowing all concerts dates, times and concert dress.
11. Students are expected to be seated and ready to sing at the beginning of rehearsal. An excused absence is illness (bedridden), personal emergency or any absence that is cleared with Mr. Young PRIOR to rehearsal.

Any singer who has a conflict with a WCS event must fill out an absence request form at least one week in advance. Singers who fail to do this will be marked unexcused.
