

Notice to Parents

In our efforts to sustain and support the food service program, the district must be financially accountable. This means that the district must collect all overdue lunch payments and unpaid balances so that the food service department can operate efficiently and affectively in providing a balanced meal for all students. Please monitor your child's account at www.mynutrikids.com or call the food service director, Jonathan Dupuis, at 286-7739 or the kitchen manager at your child's school. Your child may also check on their balances with each school's food service cashier as he/she goes through the food line.

Additionally, the School Board revised the Student Account procedure for food service at their September 20, 2010 meeting.

The new procedure will take effect Tuesday, October 12 and reads as follows:

Elementary & Middle School

When a student's account reaches a negative balance of \$10.00, the student will be informed that he/she will be served three more lunches then he/she must bring meals from home. Students must continue to bring lunches from home until their account has a positive balance.

High School

When a student accrues any negative balance, the student will be informed that he/she will be served three more lunches then he/she must bring meals from home. Students must continue to bring lunches from home until their account has a positive balance.

The food service department provides classroom teachers with weekly statements for students with negative balance accounts. These statements are sent home with students.

Families whose income does not exceed minimum requirements may qualify for the National Free and Reduced Meal Program. Families may complete an application at any time during the school year. Applications are available online at the District website www.wrsdsau59.org/departments.html or obtained from your child's school office.

Families may establish a repayment plan with the District if your child/children currently have a negative balance. Please contact Jonathan Dupuis, Food Service Director at 286-7739 or Cheryl Somma, Business Administrator at 286-4116 to establish a repayment plan.
