## **Your Eligibility**

Students who fail a course with an overall final average of 50%-64% are eligible to enroll in the 30 hour summer credit recovery program.

## **Requirements**

- 30 hours of class time
- Daily attendance
- Class work & discussion
- Portfolio of completed work
- Final exam

- Cost is \$115.00 per student per course.
- Scholarships available.
- Course(s) must be paid in full on or before the first day of class.
- Students may not take more than 2 courses in Summer Credit Recovery.
- Students must be on time.
- Missing more than one class will drop a student from the course.
- Disruptive students will be warned once by the teacher, further disruption will result action taken by the Summer School Coordinator.
- A documented warning by the Summer School Coordinator will yield a parent notification.
- Students who are asked to leave or choose to drop out before the fourth class meeting will receive a refund of \$50.00.
- Refunds will not be issued after the fourth class meeting.
- Students will be expected to do all assigned work, complete the final exam with a passing grade and maintain a class portfolio.
