Members First Credit Union will award one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$2,500.

Eligibility Qualifications:

1. Applicant must be either;
 - a) a full-time student currently enrolled or accepted to an accredited college or university undergraduate program in the field of law enforcement or criminal justice.-OR-
 - b) a full-time employee of the Manchester Police Department (MPD) pursuing a law enforcement degree at an accredited college or university.
2. Applicant must be either;
 - a) a member of Members First Credit Union. To become a member, you must live or work within a 25 mile radius of any Members First office location or have a family member that is an existing member. Once a member, you must maintain a \$5 balance in a savings account at Members First.-OR-
 - b) have a parent that has been an existing member of Members First for at least one full year.
3. The applicant must complete a current scholarship application completely and accurately. They must submit the following items with the application. **ALL items must be received in order for the application to qualify for consideration.**
 - a) a typewritten essay, no more than two pages in length (double-spaced), which addresses why they chose law enforcement as their major field of study and what their career goals are.-AND-



Selection of the winners will be made by a Committee formed of Credit Union officials. Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria; essay, grades, financial need, and extracurricular activities. Lifetime maximum of two (2) scholarships may be awarded per applicant.

Deadline: Applicants must submit their applications and accompanying material to the credit union no later than Monday, April 2, 2012. Please mail to: Members First Credit Union, Attention: Scholarship Committee, PO Box 896, Manchester, NH 03101

Winners will be notified by Friday, May 11, 2012. Award checks will be available for disbursement after completion of the first semester of school. Checks will be made payable to the student and the school.
