During the week of January 25th your students will take tests called Measures of Academic Progress™ (MAP). We give students MAP tests to determine your student's instructional level and to measure academic growth throughout the school year, and from year to year in the areas of Mathematics, Language Arts and Reading. Your student will take these tests on a computer.

MAP tests are unique in that they adapt to your student's level of learning. As a result, each student has the same opportunity to succeed and maintain a positive attitude toward testing. Additionally with MAP tests, we can administer shorter tests and use less class time while still receiving detailed, accurate information about your student's growth. Over the next few days, your student will spend about 3 hours completing these tests. Each school year, students in grades 9th and 10th take the tests in January and May. Following each testing period, you will receive a report showing your student's growth.

We are truly excited to begin a new era that focuses on every student's individual growth and achievement. **Partnering to help all students learn**, parents and teachers can have a profound positive effect on the lives of our students.
