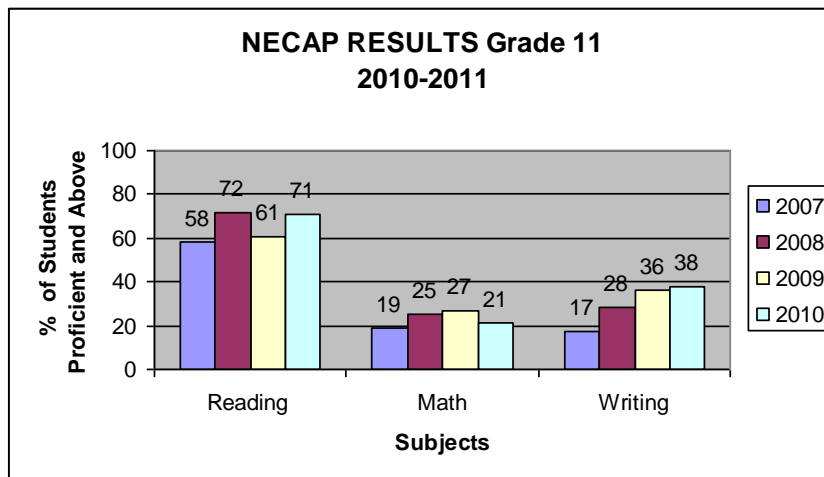

Dear WRHS Parents/Guardians,

The NECAP scores for the 2010 test administration have been released. At this time, we do not yet know our AYP status from this testing; we will be notified sometime this spring, after the DOE makes all the necessary calculations. I am pleased with our progress in writing, as we met the goal we set for ourselves with a gain of two points. Reading improved by 10 points, and we decreased seven points in Math. We will review all scores and continue to use the data to make improvements in programming moving forward. Below is a graph of our overall results prepared by Suzan Gannett, our district Curriculum Director.



Once we receive the parent copy of your child’s test results, we will be mailing them home along with your child’s winter NWEA assessment scores. Our teachers will be working collaboratively and individually to analyze assessment scores and plan changes to the delivery of instruction aimed at moving all students into the proficient range.
