Meeting called to order: Dawn Bungay called the meeting to order at 6:03 PM

In Attendance:

Minutes from January 6th, 2010 Meeting:

- A motion was made by Dawn Bungay to accept January 6th 2010 meeting minutes as is. Mike Regan seconded the motion. January 6th meeting minutes were accepted with a unanimous YES vote.

Treasurer Report – given by Lisa Swancott:

- Balance is \$348.56
- \$25.00 state of NH filing fee to be made to keep our name in good standing with the state.
- A motion was made by Peggy LaBrecque to accept the treasurer's report as is. Dr Mark Christensen seconded the motion. Treasurer's report was accepted by a unanimous YES vote.

Insurance

- Dawn Bungay received a renewal quote from our current insurance broker RV Nuccio & Associates Inc. Our insurance is due for renewal on 03/15/2010. Quote for same coverage's, General Liability @ \$1Mil and Directors & Officers coverage @ \$1Mil is \$149.00. This is less than last year as the administrative costs are not as much as this is a renewal policy and not a start up policy.
- Peggy LaBrecque made a motion to renewal our current insurance policy with the same carrier at the \$149.00 premium. Lisa Swancott seconded the motion. A vote was called and a unanimous YES vote was accepted.

Spirit Clothing:

- Don Buckwell advised that we have a small and extra small blue polo available for purchase. We still have our samples (excluding beanie).
- We have a new updated School Spirit Clothing order form that now shows larger sizes have an additional charge. Dawn will have updated order form put on our website. Peggy & Dawn will make colored copies for the office and for other times that we will be selling them.
- Don mentioned that in order for us to sell more clothing – we should speak to the athletic booster club to see if we can sell during Track & Field this spring. It would be a great idea to purchase several clothing items up front and then sell them at different events. At this time, we do not have the funds to do so. Perhaps a fundraiser will help with this.

Fundraisers:

- Dawn Bungay advised that the Annual Sportsman Show would not be taking place at WRHS as there is a date conflict.
- Dawn Bungay reviewed a fundraiser called Natalie's Coffee. The product costs \$8.00 to purchase and our proceeds would be \$1.00. It was decided that the reward would not outweigh the time/effort and we passed on this fundraiser.
- Dawn Bungay reviewed another fundraiser called Custom Shades. This is a fundraiser that would entail selling Oakley "style" sunglasses. Dawn will get more information, a brochure and see about samples and bring it up at our next meeting.
- Many other fundraising events were brought up such as: Having a spaghetti night at Tilt N' Diner; Applebee's pancake breakfast; Recycling in Concord; Scrapping at Advanced Recycling. Lisa Swancott advised that she would look into the Tilt N' Diner spaghetti dinner and let us know the details etc.

Principal Report – given by Dr Mark Christensen:
