Meeting called to order @ 6:08pm

In Attendance:

Minutes:

November 3rd minutes were reviewed, Mike Regan made a motion to accept, Bill Wilder seconded, all approved.

Craft Fair:

The Chem-free craft fair went well, PTSO bake sale table made \$138.50.

Spirit Clothing:

Four orders processed, 47 items sold. Don Buckwell started a discussion regarding stadium seats. He will look into a better price and some with or without logos. Mark Christensen brought up the potential of renting seats at games to raise funds. Student council could volunteer to be at games and rent the seats for \$1, splitting the proceeds with PTSO. PTSO will purchase an agreed upon number of seats. Don will check into different colors, logo or plain and send an e-mail to officers for an e-mail vote to allocate funds to purchase seats. Seats can also be ordered if students or parents want to own one.

Treasurer Report:

Lisa Swancott presented the treasurers report. Peggy LaBrecque made a motion to accept the treasurers report, Mike Regan seconded, all approved.

Lisa also shared a letter/licensing agreement and donation check (\$33.43) from Pel Industries, Inc. The stipulations of the letter and consequences of cashing the check were discussed. Mike Regan motioned not to accept the offer, Bill Wilder seconded and all voted not to accept.

Review Bi-Laws:

I was agreed that the Bi-Laws need to be revised. Bill Wilder recommended that Gretchen Wilder will review and check into State requirements pertaining to auditing. Discussion will be tabled until January meeting.

Principals Report:

Dr. Christensen informed the group that there will be a "mock block" scheduled for February 24 and 25th, 2011. He explained that block scheduling was 90 minute classes. Instead of 7 periods, the students have only 4 per day. This system has been very successful around the Country.

New Business:

- Don Buckwell announced that the Chorus Concert is on December 16th, and if anyone would like to donate baked items, we are volunteering to help Mr. Young with a refreshment table.
- Lisa Swancott suggested a BJ's fundraiser which is a reduced rate membership and each new or renewed membership makes \$5 for PTSO. The group was very interested and Lisa will invite the representative from BJ to speak at our February meeting and provide more details.
- Student Council is collecting items for a "12 days of charity" event. They are putting together boxes for town hall to distribute to families in the community for the holidays.
- January meeting will be at UNO's Pizzeria in Tilton from 5-7pm.
