In order to maintain a safe and productive learning environment, 6th graders are expected to be positive role models for the school. This includes:

| Prepared | ● Being prepared for all classes each and every day |
| Safe | ● Modeling safe , mature behavior while adhering to all school rules |

Failure to act in the above manner will result in receiving a RRAPS letter (corresponding to the above school rules.) If a student receives 3 letters in one week in a class, that will result in parent contact and a detention. For Science and Social Studies, which meet every-other day, the 3 letters will be for a time period of 2 weeks.

If a student receives a 3rd detention, he/she is subject to the WRMS Consequence Continuum.

Students who receive no warnings for the week will be rewarded with a Gotcha. (Every 2 weeks for Science and Social Studies.) Gotchas are like WRMS currency, and can be used throughout the year for field trips, activities, and at the Gotcha store.
