

WRMS PTO Meeting Minutes
March 2, 2010

1. Welcome – Tammy Guilmain welcomed everyone!
2. Review February Minutes – The minutes were reviewed by all those present. Tammy Guilmain made a motion to accept the February 2, 2010 minutes as written and Carolee Longley seconded the motion. We unanimously accepted the minutes as written.
3. Review Treasurer's Report – Deb shared our non-reconciled (waiting for bank statement) total as of Feb 28, 2010, which is \$1,173.77.
4. March 19th Social – We have decided to only have a 6th grade social on Friday, March 19th. In the gym we could have dodge ball, basketball, and open gym. We will have a movie and Tammy will choose a movie and Sue will get the video permission. The social will go from 2:30 – 4:30. Sue and Tammy will bring in game systems and we will have two mobile projectors set up in the gym. Tammy offered to make brownies, Deb offered to make cookies, and Sue is donating popcorn. We will charge \$3.00 to get in and water will be \$1.00. Cenanne will take care of the permission slip and collecting the money. Cenanne will also ask other teachers and staff if they would like to chaperone.
5. Tanger Fundraiser – The deadline for Tanger is March 31st. We are sending home a Tanger Coupon book order form. Order forms will be due by March 30th. 9. Other – Deb spoke with the company that audited our books last year. She asked if they could do something about the \$250.00 cost of auditing the books. The woman from the auditing company looked at our records and said it looked like they had clocked \$800.00 worth of hours auditing the books and if that is the case they wouldn't drop their price. We discussed reviewing the by-laws and amending the portion that explains when and how often we need to have our books audited.
